#### **Minimum Qualifications:**

- Must be 21 years or older
- Possess valid Driver's License
- Must have current and valid certification from the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Board and a have minimum of three (3) years experience.
- Must be currently employed with a local, county or state law enforcement agency in good standing.

#### **Skills/Abilities:**

- Excellent oral and written communication skills
- knowledge of modern law enforcement principles, procedures, techniques, and equipment; considerable knowledge of applicable laws (federal, state and local) ordinances, and department rules and regulations
- Ability to operate the following: police vehicles, police radio, handgun and other defensive weapons as required, computer, body-worn camera
- Ability to exercise sound judgment in evaluating situations and making decisions
- Knowledge of Microsoft Office products (Word, Excel, PowerPoint)

### **Essential Duties/Responsibilities:**

- Perform general patrol of municipality in patrol vehicle or on foot / Crime Prevention
- Perform patrol functions / criminal assignments: respond to calls/complaints, traffic enforcement
- Perform non-criminal assignments such as completion of police reports, assist with motorist aids, vehicle lock-outs, and traffic control at accident scenes, crowd control at special events, assist FD personnel, prisoner processing, evidence collection / storage, impound vehicles / tow releases, training
