After Hours Domestic Violence Court

The Domestic Violence Division of the Circuit Court of Cook County has launched after-hours access, via remote proceedings, for Civil Emergency Orders of Protection. In addition to regular court hours, Monday to Friday, 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM, remote hearings are now available Monday to Friday, 9:00 PM to 3:00 AM and Saturday and Sunday, 1:00 PM to 6:00 PM. During extended hours, people may access forms to request a Civil Emergency Order of Protection hearing by visiting [Illinois Legal Aid Online](#). Hearings for Criminal Orders of Protection will not be heard during extended hours.

Garage Burglary Prevention Tips

- Lock your garage doors; padlock the track if not used regularly
- Zip tie your emergency door release
- Don't leave your garage doors open unnecessarily
- Use a smart garage door opener
- Cover your garage windows
- Improve your garage's exterior lighting
- Ensure your garage doors are in good condition
- Access doors should be solid core access door with a deadbolt
- Don't leave valuables in your garage or vehicles
- Use a remote opener on a keychain
- Lock up your tools in cabinets
