On November 9th, 2024 at approximately 1:09pm the Country Club Hills Police Department responded to the area of 17401 S Pulaski RD, Hillcrest High School in reference to a "Gunshot Victim". Through the preliminary investigation it was learned that this incident was a "Homicide". It was learned that the high school gymnasium was being utilized for a grammar school basketball tournament. Further, it was discovered that during the tournament multiple armed offenders were laying in wait at the back of the high school parking lot in a completely tinted black 4 door Infinity Q50. When the offenders observed the victim, who was accompanied by his juvenile son exit the high school, they proceeded toward the victim in the black Infinity Q50 and blocked the victims path to his vehicle. At this time the occupants of the vehicle exited with weapons drawn and opened fire on the victim. The offenders ultimately fled the scene southbound through the parking lot towards Pulaski Rd. The victim was transported to the local hospital for medical treatment where he succumbed to his injuries.

At this time there are no subsequent reported injuries related to this incident and appears to be an isolated incident.

The above is an active investigation and is being conducted with the assistance of the South Suburban Major Crimes Task Force.
