



ELECTRICAL COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL CODES

An Electrical Contractor who is registered by the City of Country Club Hills must do all Electrical work done on premises. A Permit must be issued before work is started.

All Electrical signs must have a permit. No extension cords can be longer than six feet and must be three-wire.

All duplex outlets must be groundable typed.

Electrical panels must be readily available at all times

All electrically operated machines with water attached must have a disconnect switch near machine.

Codes adopted by Reference

The City of Country Club Hills follows the National Electrical Code-2002 Edition and certain addendum found in Chapter 14.7.01-14.7.17

ARTICLE 7 PLUMBING REGULATIONS

14.701 PERMITS:

A. No person, firm or corporation shall install or alter any plumbing with the City unless he is a licensed plumber and until a permit has been secured for such installation or alteration from the Deputy Commissioner of Plumbing, and upon payment of a prescribed fee in advance.

B. Application for such permits shall be made upon printed forms to be furnished by the Deputy Commissioner of Plumbing, and each application shall set out the name of owners of the premises where the proposed work is to be done, the location thereof, by street and number, and a detailed description of the proposed plumbing installation or alteration sufficient to show that the proposed work is in conformity with the provisions of this Chapter.
